In order for the parish to meet its regular expenses, our offertory and other designated parish collections must bring in **\$8,700** per week.

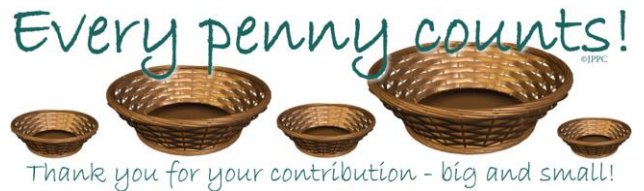
