

You will notice that something is different in next month's packet of Sunday offering envelopes. After comparison with the envelope company the parish has used, we have made a switch to Our Sunday Visitor (OSV) of Huntington, Indiana. This change was made for economic reasons and because the appearance of the envelopes is superior.

Because it is my responsibility to see that we are not wasteful with our resources, we will not send envelopes to those who have not used them over the past 2 years. Some parishioners prefer to drop cash in the basket, some are unable to contribute, and some choose not to do so.
