CREATION CORNER: Luke 9:11 This weekend's Gospel includes seven verses. The last six verses relate the feeding of the 5,000. But the first verse sets the stage: "Jesus spoke to the crowds about the kingdom of God, and he healed those who needed to be cured." Jesus' priority was to explain the Kingdom of God, as He did in the Sermon on the Mount. Only then did he minister to the people's need for physical healing and nourishment. Economics is known as the "dismal science," because it deals with the allocation of scarcity. Jesus' economics deals with the abundance of Creation: spiritual and physical. And the spiritual comes first!
