QUO VADIS AND FIAT VOCATION CAMPS

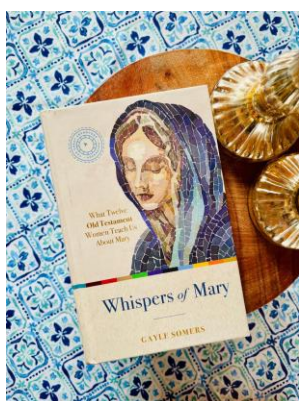

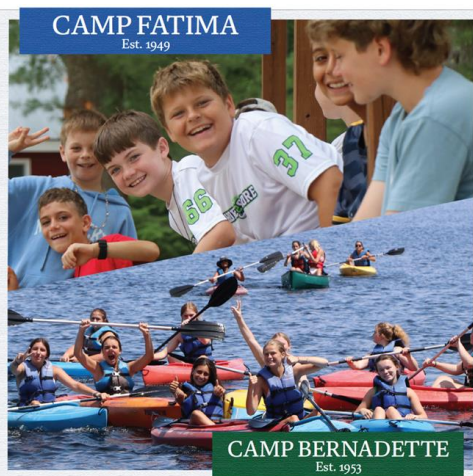
