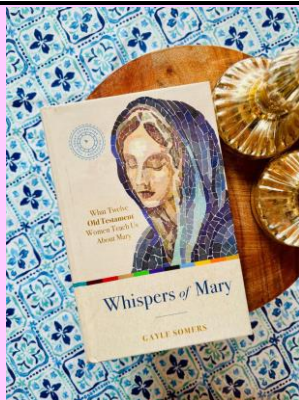

HEARING ASSISTANCE AT MASS

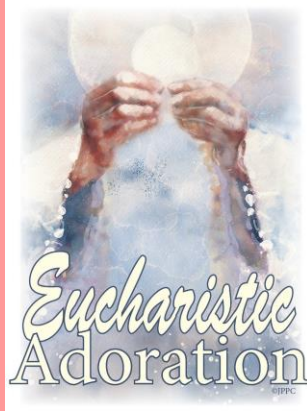
