Dear parishioners at Saint Patrick Parish,

It is hard to say goodbye to all of you in this beloved parish. When I was assigned to your parish, I felt strange and a little bit nervous in a new parish, new city, new land, and new environment even though I was assigned to three parishes before: Saint Ignatius of Loyola in Somersworth, Saint Catherine of Siena Parish in Manchester, and Sainte Marie Parish in Manchester. However, Father Von and all of you welcome me as a member of your family at Saint Patrick Parish. I am grateful for your generosity and hospitality in helping me grow in faith, love, and charity, as I learned about ministry in this parish.

My pastoral year has been so fast and every single day at Saint Parish is a grace from God. I was helped by friendly people in Pelham so I would like to borrow Psalm "Give thanks to the Lord, for he is good; his love endures forever" (Psalm 118:1). In this last bulletin article, I want to express my gratitude from bottom of my heart to Father Von, Father Kelley, the staff, and all the parishioners for all you have done for me while I lived at Saint Patrick Parish.

After Christmas and New Year, I tried my best to remember you all, especially your faces, your smiles, and your family in every Sunday Mass. Through you and how you join and support this parish and the Church, I have grown in love of God and the Church every single day.
