GETTING TO KNOW THE PASTOR

Dear brothers and sisters in Christ, it is with great joy that I have been blessed to be named your new pastor by Bishop Libasci, the Bishiop of Manchester. I would like to send you this brief letter of introduction so that you may know more about me.

I have been a priest of Jesus Christ for 36 years. I am the fourth of ten children born to Paul and Patricia Grace who have entered the glory of our Lord. Dad was a career Army officer and my mom was a great woman of family and faith. I grew up with my siblings mostly in the Midwest before my dad retired and we moved to Manchester.

I attended Benedictine College in Atchison, Kansas where I received my bachelor's degree in sports medicine. After graduation I went to Mount Saint Mary Seminary in Emmitsburg, Maryland, were I received my priestly formation and received my masters in Divinity and Sacred Scripture.

I was ordained in 1988 by Bishop Odore Gendron and was assigned to St. Joseph Parish in Nashua. Afterwards, I attended Duquesne University in Pittsburg and received a master's in Spiritual Theology and the Science of Spiritual Formation. When I returned to Manchester, I resided at St. Marie's for fourteen years and served the bishop as the director of Spiritual Renewal and the director of the Office of Worship. I then transitioned and founded Parable Magazine for the diocese.

Afterwards, I was assigned as pastor of Resurrection Parish in Nashua for fifteen years and now I make the wonderful journey to St. Patrick in Pelham. I am truly excited and I feel extremely blessed to take on this great responsibility of serving you and journeying with you as we follow Jesus Christ.

In the weeks ahead we will get to know each other better on this Pilgrimage of Faith and as my mom told me to always let people know, wherever I go, "Please be patient with me, God isn't finished with me yet."
