"Aahhh Facetime with Jesus. For me, this is a time to reflect and really be present with Jesus. He is so present. Sometimes I can feel His presence and sometimes I can't, but I know He is there. It is a time for me to go deeper into scripture or to read that book about a saint or even ask Him to help me write a book about a topic He wants me to share. For the last six years, I have spent a minimum of one hour/week in Adoration. Typically, I spend 2-3 hours per week which allows me to find internal peace, express my gratitude to God for all He has provided and to allow Him to touch my heart and mind. Spending time with Him allows Him to adjust how I see situations and opens my heart to forgiveness and love. I like to journal during Adoration and write down insights He gives me while we are together. I like face to face meetings and being with people, so this gives me that face to face time with Jesus. It's like I get to hang out with my best friend for an uninterrupted hour. Unless, of course, my mind wanders. But He always brings me back. Sometimes I just snuggle up with Him and have fallen asleep in peace. When I arise, I feel recharged. There is no wrong way to spend time with Him (just try not to snore LOL).
